

WHAT TO DO IF YOU'RE IN AN ACCIDENT.

1 IMMEDIATELY DIAL 911.

Call the police right away. Also, if you or any of your passengers are injured, ask the 911 operator to send medical attention. When the police arrive, offer your license, registration and proof of insurance. (That means you should always keep these items with you while driving.) Do not volunteer any unnecessary information. Be truthful but don't admit fault of any kind.

2 TAKE PHOTOS

If you or someone in your vehicle can safely take photos of the accident scene do so. Use the camera on your mobile phone if you have one. Taking photos of the crash scene before it is cleared can make a critical difference should the crash become a legal matter.

3 CALL THE LAW OFFICE OF STEVE WATREL (WE'RE STANDING BY 24 HOURS A DAY.)

As soon as a few minutes after an accident occurs, representatives of the other driver's insurance company may already have starting devising a plan on how to resolve any accident disputes in their own favor. If you talk with the insurance company of the other driver give only your insurance information.
